Plastic Red top tubes now have an additive

- a clot activator is spray coated inside the collection tube

Plastic Red tops <u>must now be mixed by inversion 8-10 times</u>

- mix the clot activator with the blood to initiate clotting

The additive <u>affects the order blood collection tubes are drawn</u> (order of draw)

- must now draw red top tubes <u>after</u> light blue sodium citrate tubes to prevent erroneous test results in the light blue tube
- see the order of draw flyer dated November 2009
